# DUCSU, BCL leaders call for new trend

General Secretary of the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) Mr Ziauddin Bablu said in Dhaka on Wednesday that the need of the day is to keep the students above narrow party politics and he urged the students to join the "new trend" to be introduced by him very soon, reports BSS.

Urging the student community not to "involve themselves in the quicksand of anarchy" Mr Bablu told a Press conference on Wednesday afternoon at the Jatiya Press Club that the students should now "shun the path of terrorism" and should engage themselves for establishing

the real "ism" through "real idealistic struggle".

He said to create conducive atmosphere in the educational institutions for developing "ideal citizens". "There should be an environment for study and research, restoration of teacher-student relationship, and non-use of the students, teachers and the educational campuses in activities of party politics."

Mr. Bablu also read out a 11-point charter of demands which included evolving a pro-people and work-oriented education system, concession for the students in public transports, construction of halls and hostels, arrangement of part-time job opportunities for the college and university students and assurance of employment after student-life.

Replying to a question the DUCSU General Secretary said that programmes of the Student Action Committee during the last few months were "wrong and anarchic". He urged the students to place their legitimate rights to the proper authorities and advised them to try to fulfil their demands through

ugh constitutional means.

The conference was also attended by few members of the DUCSU and pro-BSD Chhatra League. They are Mr Delwar Hossain Reza, Organising Secretary, Bangladesh Chhatra League Central Committee, Mr Azam Khan, Member, Chhatra League Central Committee Mr Shahjahan, Secretary, Common Room, DUCSU Mr Farid Ahmed Member; DUCSU Mr Anwar Hossain, Member, DUCSU, Mr Swapan Chowdhury, Member DUCSU, Mr Zillur Ahmad Dipu VP S M Hall Students Union, and Mr Iqbal Member, Chhatra League.

F.N.A adds: Mr. Bablu said they will soon announce their decision on the formation of a "new organisation" which will seek to keep the student community above party politics.

He said student community should not involve itself in any party politics.

The DUCSU leader maintained that one should not oppose anything only for oppositions sake "Student community should develop an attitude to support any good thing from any quarter" he added.

Answering a question he said they will have no reservation to accept the good things from any quarter including the present government.

Replying to another question he said: "the present government has only some educational proposals and not an education policy. We will certainly not support any proposal if it goes against student-community."
