

2 school students shot at, 25 injured in city

Two school students were shot at and at least 25 persons injured, three of them seriously, in a clash between members of two local clubs at Ibrahimpur under Cantonment police station at about 1 p.m. on Tuesday.

Three of the injured persons were admitted to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital while others were given first aid. Police arrested four persons in this connection.

According to police, the trouble originated from a quarrel between two members of Friends Club and Srijan Club at a local restaurant. The quarrel soon spread and

members of both the clubs attacked each other with deadly weapons including bombs. Police claimed that two students were hit by splinters of bombs and not by bullets.

Those admitted to the hospital were: Ebadullah (16), a student of class IX of Cantonment school, Moqbul Hossain (7), a student of class II of Lala Saraj Primary School (they received bullet wounds), and Mamun (12) a student of class VI of Naval School. Mamun was stabbed.

Police arrested four persons. They were: Kazal Bhuiyan, Mofiz, Shawkat Hossain and Delwar Hossain.
