JU BUDGET OKAYED

The Jahangirnagar University Senate approved an original budget of Taka five crore 45 lable with a surplus of Taka 23 lakh 20 thousand for 1937-88 fiscal year in its sixth annual meeting held on Monday with Vice-Chancellor Prof AFM Kamaluddin in the chair.

Prof Manammad Noman, Treasurer of the university, placed the budget before the i senate. The budget showed a net income of about Taka 5 crore 68 lakh and 20 thousand including Taka five crore \$20 lakh as grant from the University Grants Commission (UGC) and Taka 25 lakh as revenue from the university's own sources.
