## k-2.38 cr EEC grant for rural primary schools

LINAJFUR, Mar. 6: The Europian Economic Community (EEC) will construct 67 government primary school buildings in three northern districts of Panchagarh, Thakurgaon and Dinajour during the current tinancial year.

According to a report, - the LEC has allocated an amount of Taka 2,38,68,756 for constructing 67 semi-pucca buildings of government primary schools in these three districts. Of the amount, Taka 1,45,28,898. has been allocated for 42 school buildings in 13 upazilas of Dinaspur district, Taka; (9.18,40) for 20 school buildings in five upazilas under Thakurgaon district and an amount of Taka 24,21,468 has been allocated for 7 primary school buildings in five upazilas under Panchagarh

 Construction work of most. of the school buildings have al., from the curse of illiteracy. ready been started which will be completed by June 1989.

Meanwhile a discussion on, the role of voluntary organisations in mass education programme was held recently at the 'Lokabhavan' in Dinajpur.
