Upgrading Chaumuhani College

During the recent visit of the Chief Martial Law Administrator Lt. Gen. H. M. Ershad to the Chaumuhani College, a popular demand of upgrading the college to the university college was placed. But it has been announced by the government that the college will be given the status of a government college.

Now that the government has decided to upgrade one college at each and every district to university college. Under the circumstances, the Chaumuhani College Old Boys' Association, in its Gene-

ral Body Meeting held recently unanimously resolved to impress upon the government to upgrade the Chaumuhani College to the university college on the following grounds amongst other reasons:

(a) This is the biggest college in the district in respect of the strength of students and staff, (b) it is located at the central place of the district, (c) sufficient space or accommodation is available ground the present premises of the college for its possible future expansion, (d) the college being situated adjacent to the biggest market (Chaumuhani) and also within one mile of the biggest industrial unit of the district (Delta Jute Mills), it will benefit thousands of poor and deserving students.

I would, therefore, earnestly request the government to upgrade the college to the university college at the earliest possible time so that a long standing demand of a neglected area is fulfilled.
