DU MA final classes begin Oct. 2

Students of the University of Dacca who have appeared at the M.A. Preliminary and Degree Honours Examinations of 1976 held in 1978, have been asked to get themselves admitted provisionally into the Final Year Master Degree classes for the session 1976-77 by September 30, 1978. Final Year Master Degree classes will begin October 2, says a DU Press release.

All provisional admissions will have to be confirmed within 15 days of publication of results by applying to the Registrar through the Provost of the Hall concerned. Admissions of unsuccessful candidates will automatically be cancelled and they will have to get refund of their admission fees within 30 days of publication of results.

Radio commercial service extended

Radio Bangladesh has extended the time of its commercial service in order to provide adequate publicity to the industrial goods and products of the country, according to an official source.

The extended commercial service programme, viz, 'Bigyan Taranga', will be broadcast in the evening transmission everyday on 365.85 metre and 820 kilo hertz in medium wave according to the following schedule: 4.30 p.m. to 5.55 p.m.; 6.30 p.m. to 7 p.m.; 9 p.m. to 9.30 p.m. and 10 p.m. to 11 p.m.

The extended commercial service includes some new programmes, such as 'music around the world', 'Gitalee', 'Ujan Bhati', 'Pop music' and 'Chhoto-monider anushthan'.
