

Local govt institute at Comilla urged

COMILLA, Aug. 30: Establishment of a local government institute at Comilla was demanded by the chairmen of different union parishads and thana development committees while they were participating in a oneday training course of the chairmen, secretaries, and treasurers of thana development committees on rural works held on Saturday at the Conference Room of the Deputy Commissioner, Comilla. The training course was organised by district administration.

Speaking at the training course Mr. Kutubuddin Choudhury Selim, Chairman of Chandura Union Parishad under Bhabla subdivision urged upon the Government particularly the Ministry of Local Government, to set up a local government institute at Comilla.
