## Teachers asked The Bandesh Time to refund money drawn as salary

KURIGRAM, Aug. 17: Six pri mary school teachers of Dahagram under Patgram police station were issued orders for refunding Taka about 27,500 which they drew as their salaries for the last several morths.

According to a report, the Thana Education Officer, Patgram submitted a report against these six teachers of Dahagram for neglect of duties. On this report, the District Inspector of Schools, Rangour ssued an order to the effect that the teachers bad f overdrawn Taka 27,438 which should be refunded to the Government without further delay. The teachers have also been transferred with an instruction for joining their new places within seven days of the receipt of the order.

In compliance to the transfer order the teachers were procurement programme, it had duly released from their duties but they were not allowed to join their new posts at the places under the some police station by the Thana Education Officer. The teachers thus have been put into the dilammetic position. They did not get their salaries for the last two months. By this time the said teachers have submitted written allegation against the Thana Education Officer to the higher authorrities seeking impartfal enquiry into the matter and doing justice to them at an early date.
