# Tk. 12.75 lakh for four colleges

**KURIGRAM** Aug. 15.—An amount of Taka 12 lakh and 75 thousand was sanctioned by the Government for the development of four degree colleges in Kurigram Subdivision.

According to an official source, the Government sanctioned Taka four lakh and 75 thousand for Kurigram College, Taka four lakh for Lalmonirhat College and Taka four lakh for Ulipur College. The development works of Kurigram and Lalmonirhat College are going on but the works of the Ulipur College have not yet been started.

## Madrassahs

The development works of four senior madrassahs in Kurigram Subdivision have been completed at a cost of taka two lakh 18 thousand.

The Satdargah Senior Madrassah in Ulipur, Golerhat Senior Madrassah in Nageswari and Kurigram Senior Madrassah in Kurigram were sanctioned Taka 78 thousand each and Teesta Senior Madrassah was granted Taka 24 thousand for develop-

ment works for the year 1977-78. The development works of these four madrassah have been completed with the allotted amount.

## Primary schools

The repair and reconstruction works of 296 primary schools in Kurigram subdivision have not yet been completed.

According to an official source, 296 primary schools in Kurigram Subdivision were taken under development scheme for repair and reconstruction, which were to be completed within June 1978. But 50 per cent works of only 102 primary schools have been completed till now. The works of 94 primary schools in Ulipur and Kurigram Police Stations under the scheme have not yet been started. Each of the schools under this scheme would get Taka 17500 to Taka 25,000 in three phases. The allotted money under the first and second phases has already been received by the schools but the allotted money under the third phase is yet to be paid.
