

World's second test-tube baby

CALCUTTA Oct 5: World's second Test tube baby is claimed to have been born here at 11-14 hours on Tuesday last, according to a group of three scientists, reports PTL.

The baby born in a Calcutta nursing home weighed three kg 350 grams.

The process through which this experiment was successfully carried out was described as "unique" in a television interview here tonight. The scientists including a gynaecologist and a physiologist are: Dr. Saroj Kanti Bhattacharya, Prof Sunit Mukharjee and Dr. Subash Mukharjee.

The baby's parents were married 19 years ago, but could know the joy of having a child only last Tuesday.
