BSS adds: The women's committee of BNP on Friday described the incident of Rajshahi in which two Ministers were confined and subjected to harassment as 'undesirable and sad.'

The meeting with Dr. Mrs. Amina Rahman in the chair held at the party office also condemned the harassment of the two Ministers.

According to a Press release, the meeting also condemned 'the naked attack' on the Vice-President on March 21 in Dacca.

The women's branch of the BNP demanded punishment of those responsible for setting a bus on fire and destroyed national property.

The members of the women's branch and the members of the public have been requested to maintain law and order providing active cooperation to the democratic process.
