## The Ban Injunction on Law Secretary, BJD Chairman

On an application filed by Mr. Md. Fazlul Huq Mokbul, convener of proposed Bangladesh Jatiytabāāi Dal, Mr. Mom taz Ali Bhuiyan, Munsif, 1st Court Dacca on Tuesday issued notices upon Secretary, Ministry of Law and Parliamentary Affairs, Government of Bangladesh Defendant No. 1 Bangladesh Chairman, Defendant Jativatabadi Dal No. 2 to show cause within three weeks from the date of receipt of notices why Defendant No. 1 should not be restrained by an order of temporary injunction to allow the Defendant No. 2 to use name of the plaintiff's proposed political party Bangladesn Jatiyatababi Dal' and to carry cart the political activities in the name of his party till hearing of this petition.

The petitioner's case that he was a politician and organised a political party under the banner of 'Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Dal' and prepared its constitution, declaration and papers and other relevant party the docments of recogniobtaining from the Government tion. On October 28, 1973 he submitted an application with requisite papers to the Ministry of Law and Parliamentary Affairs for approval of the party in the name of Bangladesd Jatiya tabadi Dal."

His further contention was that after submitting the appication he was eagerly waiting for the recognition of his party. But he did not receive eny information regarding the recognition of the party from the ministry as yet.

· He contended that in one **surprise** morning with utter he found a news item in the newspapers that a new political party named "Bangladesh Jatiyatabadi Dal" had come into being. He rushed to the Ministry of Law and did not get any satisfactory reply from the Ministry regarding proposed party's name. creation of the new party in the proposed name of his party had caused irreperable loss end injuries to him as well as to other members and supporters of his party.

He claimed that Defendant No. 1 had acted most illegally and arbitrarily by allowing the Defendant No. 2 to use the name of his proposed party end thereby damaged the future prosperities of his party.

Mr. Mohammed All advocate along with Messrs Munshi Fak rul Islam Md. Alauddin Raqci buddin Ahmed and M. L. Bhowmik moved the petition for the plaintiff.
