Mominuddin made envoy to Nepal

The government has decided to appoint Mr. Mominuddin Ahmed as Ambassador of Bangladesh to the Kingdom of Nepal. It was officially announced in Dacca on Saturday reports BSS

Born on January 7, 1929, Mr. Ahmed obtained Masters degree in Political Science in 1953 from the University of Dacca and had his LL.B. in 1954. He joined the Khulna Bar in 1956. He was elected Vice-Chairman of Khulna Municipal Committee in 1958 and was elected member of the then East Pakistan Assembly in 1970.

Mr. Mominuddin Ahmed was elected president of the governing body of Haji Mohsin College Daulatpur and was also elected President of Khulna branch of the Bangladesh Family Planning Association. He was elected member of the Parliament of Bangladesh in 1973. He was Honorary Director of Bangladesh Fisheries Development Corporation in 1973.

The Ambassador-designate was State Minister in August 1975 in-charge of the Ministry of Power, Water Resources and Flood Control. He is at present a member of the National Executive Committee of the Bangladesh Nationalist Party.

Mr. Mominuddin Ahmed is married and has four sons and two daughters.
