

Body to probe SSC leakage

State Minister for Education Abdul Baten told the Jatiyo Sangsad on Wednesday that an committee was set up to probe into the reported leakage of a question paper of the current S S C Examination, reports ENA.

Participating in a discussion on the reported leakage of the question of English II paper at Shibpur Examination Centre under Narsindi on March 23 Mr Baten informed the House that the board authority has constituted an enquiry committee which is still probing into the matter.

The discussion was initiated by A.S.M Solaiman (Gano Front) It was participated by Mohammad Toaha Samyabadi Dal) and

Mr Almas Hossain (Muslim League).

Mr. Solaiman said the leakage of question paper reflects failure of the Education Administration and rampant corruption in the society. He said not only the students but also the Administration and teachers should be held responsible for this.

Replying to Opposition's criticisms Mr. Baten said that the question papers are kept under the direct supervision of the respective boards. He said question papers are not kept under the custody of the Ministry and as such the employees of the Ministry should be blamed for any leakage.
