

Fresh exam for all SSC papers ruled out

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) Examination which was postponed following detection of leakage of question papers will resume on May 24 as announced earlier.

The Controller of Examinations of the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Dacca on Friday ruled out the possibility of cancellation of the all examinations held so far. When his attention was to rumour in certain quarters that other examinations held earlier were likely to be cancelled the Controller said that it has been decided at the highest level to cancel the examination of Islamiat and Chemistry only. The question of cancelling other papers does not arise, he said.

False mark-sheet cases detected in Rangpur

RANGPUR, May 4:—Ten students including two girls of Rangpur Medical College were found to have submitted false and fictitious mark-sheets and got themselves admitted into the First Year MBBS Class.

The detection was made by the college authorities recently after a thorough scrutiny of the mark-sheets produced by the students of current session.

Further scrutiny of mark-sheets is continuing.

It may be recalled that 10 students have been expelled from the Dacca Medical College recently for submitting false mark-sheets.
