

Papers on Islamic subjects invited

In connection with holding the three-day 'World Islamic Law Seminar' scheduled to be held in October this year under the auspices of Bangladesh Lawyers' Islamic Council at Khulna, papers have been invited from eminent jurists and Ulema of the country who intend to participate in it, reports BSS.

According to Press release of the council, the papers on the following in triplicate within 13 typed pages either in Bengali or English will be submitted to Sk. Abdul Karim, Khulna Bar Association, Khulna by March 31.
