Universe may have other civilisations

MOSCOW, Feb. 3.—The President of the Soviet Academy of Sciences said on Friday he did not exclude the possibility of other civilisations in the unit verse, says AFP.

In the newspaper Troud quoted by Tass today, atomic physicist Anatoli Alexandrov said; The present level of science does not permit us to confirm or deny the existance of an extra_terre trial civilisation.

In the vast universe there are a sufficient number of pianetary systems. It is completel on sible that some stars have natural conditions close to those of earth suitable for the development of life. All that is spossible but we cannot say either 'yes' or 'no',

he added.
Radio signals received on earth were being continually studied. Everything received or recorded has a natural expranation and for he moment there was no like with such a civilisation.
