RU Hons students urge NU to reschedule exams

RAJSHAHI, Oct 10:—Students of various colleges of Degree Honours course under National University this noon put barricade on various points of the city roads and outskirts demanding elimination of mass corruption and irregularities of National University and re-scheduling of examination dates of Honours Part-3 and Degree Pass Course of 1998.

Hundreds of students put barricade on the road in front of Rajshahi College from 12.00 to 1.00 p.m. and while student of Nawhala Degree College put barricade on Rajshahi-Naogan, Road from 11.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m. and students of Premtali Degree College and Godagari Degree College put barricade on Rajshahi-Chapainawabganj highway from 11.00 a.m. to 12.00 noon to press home the same demands.

Roadside meetings were also held in front of the respective colleges during the blocked. The speakers in the meeting demanded re-scheduling of various examination dates specially examination of Honours Party-3 and Degree Pass Examinations scheduled to be held on October 27 and November 19 respectively. The organisers of the blocked programme also brought out a procession in the city headed by Abul Kalam Azad, President of Jatyatabadi Chhatra Dal of Rajshahi College Unit.

Fast demanding exam results

One Farhad Mahmud, an examinee of Final Year of Master Degree of the Department of Social Work under Rajshahi University started fast unto death in front of department office from this morning demanding publication of results of the examination within seven days.

Campus sources said, the Final Examination of 1994 of Social Work Department started on November 17 last year and ended within a month but the result of examination was not published even after lapse of ten months.
