Teacher shortage in Sunamganj Govt College

Government Degree Sunamganj College has been facing manifold problems hampering the education in the college.

Shortage of teachers, inadequate library facility, absence of auditorium, play ground, shortage of furniture are some of the problems facing the college for a long time.

The college has been running with only 31 teachers against 65 sanctioned posts. The English Department is running with only one teacher though there are four sanctioned posts. Three out of four posts? in Zoology Deportment have been lying vacant for a long time. Islamic History and Statistics Departments are not opened as these were introduced before nationalisation of the college in 1980. Honours course has not yet been introduced in the college.

Students are deprived of reference books and the books available at the college library are not up to the standard.

During the examination desks and; benches are to hired. Besides, the students of many colleges which have not yet been permitted to set up centre appeared in this college. The science laboratory can not serve the purpose of the students as it is poorly equipped.

Apr 4:—The sides, many important functions and meetings can not be held for want of hall room. A classroom is being used as auditorium. The play ground near the college where water always remain stagnant is located in a lowlying land affecting the sports activities of the students.

There are 1,400 students including girls students studying in the college. There is no boundary wall or bencee around the campus.
