Ananda Mohan College closed sine die

MYMENSINGH, July 17:
Mymensingh Government
Ananda Mohan College has
been declared closed sine die
and the students asked to vacate
the hostel by 9 am today, reports UNB.

Academic Council of the college took the decision at an emergency meeting Friday night following a violent protest on the college campus the previous day.

On Thursday, a group of agitated students, in protest against what they said illegal toll collection by outsiders, ransacked the residence and office of the Principal, students union office and burnt the college bus.

The students, however, rejected the decision of the closure and staged a protest raily on the campus today. They also submitted a memorandum to the principal demanding immediate reopening of the college. The students have decided not to leave the dormitories.

Meanwhile, the college authorities alleged that they did not get any police protection even after repeated requests. They filed a case with Kotowali thana in connection with the ransacking of college property.
