Feni Degree Exam.

Centre

Sir,

We express our sense of protest at some of the news published on the 7th Sept. 1987 in the Bangladesh Observer.

The charge that the centre was cancelled following mass copying in the Examination centre and assault on a University invigilator is not true. Strict measures were adopted to maintain complete discipline and consequently 127 examinees were expelled from the examination hall.

The misbehaviour of the lady examinee with the University invigilator was at once severely dealt with by the Officer-in-charge of the Exam. centre. A case was filed with the Feni Thana (Vide, Case no. 2338/4, dated 11-9-86) against the said lady examinee. And while she was about to be handed over to the police, the concerned University invigilator requested the Officer-in-charge not to do so. The statement that 'the life of the External invigilator', who detected the unfair means of the alleged lady examinee, was threatened by the student mobs is false.

It may be mentioned that despite

the request of the College authority (Vide Memo No. 2192, dated 3-3-86) not to send external candidates because of shortage of accommodation, invigilators, furniture etc. the University authority sent as many as 1155 external candidates, that created heavy pressure on the administration at the centre.

The Examination authority cannot, therefore, be held solely responsible for anything that happened due to various unusual circumstances.
