BCS (Edn) members to observe strike Sept 1, 2

Teachers of BCS General Education Cadre decided to observe a token strike for two days on September 1 and 2 if their 16-point demand is not met by August 31.

The demands include giving higher scales to the teachers as admissible and removing disparities in respect of seniority and promotion, creation of new posts, departmental promotion including 20 per cent reserve posts and awarding ten per cent selection grade to the Associate Professors, says a Press release.

Leaders of BCS General Education Cadre in a statement said many a time the Education Ministry took decisions of solving the teachers' problems and the association postponed its programme, but the problems were not solved.

The teachers will go for a greater movement after their general meeting to be held at Teachers' Training College, Dhaka, on September 3 if their demands are not fulfilled, they added.
