The year 1996 saw major development in all areas of the University life:

...The students enrollment exceeded the target of 450. It was 485. Revenue jumped by 42 percent, most of the increase came from tuition fees. Senior students took their internship and job experience in a host of national and multi-national organisations and one attended a graduate workshop on environmental communication at an university abroad...

..There has been a large expansion of the faculty including recruitment of sabbatical and volunteer scholars and inter university fellows. One teacher received her Ph.D., one teacher went for higher studies on IUB-ODA scholarship. Several teachers attended professional meetings abroad and published articles in professional journals abroad and at home. Two workshops were held on faculty orientation and development. Academic administration was strengthened by the recruitment of the Deputy Registrar and more technical staff in counseling and registry...

...The teaching aids and facilities were expanded by the establishment of the Ispahani Composite Laboratory

(Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Environmental Science) and the Monem Computer Station with supporting information technology. The Library books and facilities were increased..

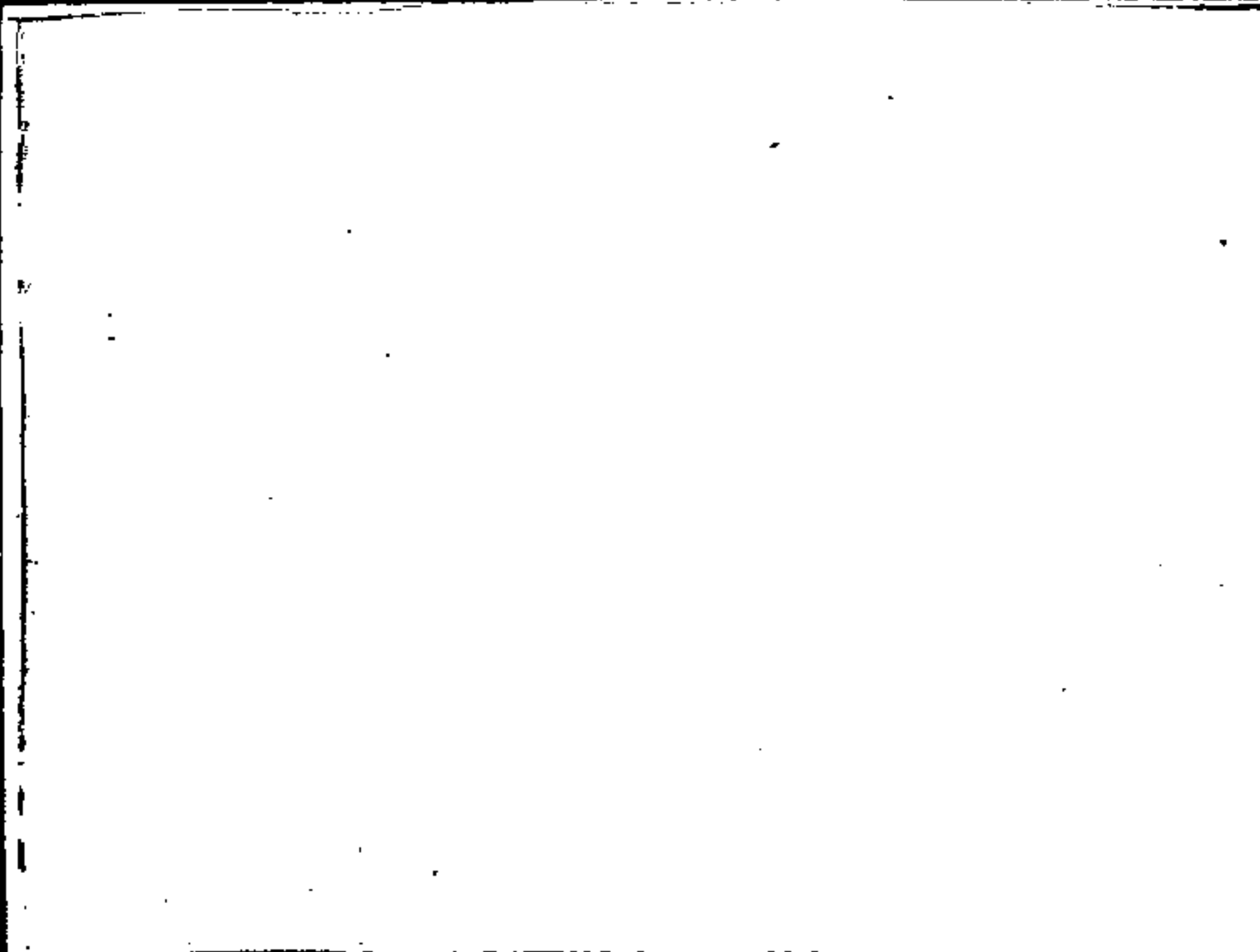
