

## Combine for DUCSU polls

DHAKA, May 19 (UNB). The Combine of nine Left-oriented student organisations is likely to fight the June 6 DUCSU and Hall Union elections jointly in deference to the desire of its parent parties, campus and party sources said.

Although formal talks among the components are yet to begin, most of the top leaders of the Combine admitted that announcement of a joint panel was almost obvious at present.

They said participation in DUCSU polls is part of their struggle for establishing people's rule in the country and only a joint panel could justify this political stand.

Leaders of the Five-Party Alliance at a meeting last week

agreed on principle about a joint panel in DUCSU elections and forwarded their suggestion to respective student bodies for consideration, a source close to the meeting told UNB.

The Combine is comprised of nine student organisations affiliated with the Five-Party Alliance and its allies, including the United Communist League.

A formal meeting of the Combine will be held following the completion of discussions at party levels, said Mushtaq Hossain DUCSU General Secretary and a top leader of the Combine.
