BCU announces panel for DUCSU polls

Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) the student wing of CPB on Thursday announced its panel for the ensuing Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) and hall union polls scheduled to be held on June 6. Mr. Mustafizur Rahman Babul President of the party is Vice-President candidate while present Assistant General Secretary of DUCSU and party GS Nasiruddoza candidate for the post of General Secretary. Mr. Yasin Alpona a present member of DUCSU, is contesting for the post of Assistant General Secretary.

The BCU leaders announced their panel at a Press conference at the DUCSU office on the day. The press conference was addressed by Mr. Mustafizur Rahman Babul.

The BCU a major partner of the now defunct Central Students Action Committee (CSAC) which won the DUCSU polls last year explained its stand why they took the policy to go alone this year. The BCU President said we are not against any broad unity. But BCU is not in

favour of a unity which only seeks to win come posts and positions in DUCSU he added. He said that although the CSAC got massive mandate last year, it could not keep the commitment to the general students. The CASC failed to fulfil its pledge to free from armed terrorism. even the role of DUCAU was not in favour of a mass student movement against the present regime the BCU President said.

The BCU President said his party tried its best to build a broad based unity on the basis of minimum issue the Union President said his organisation criticised the narrow outlook of Chhatra League (H-A) student front of Awami League and also against the separate stand of the nine student organisation.

The BCU President said a recent meeting of the party central committee and national council decided that it would go alone in all students union elections except in the case of movement against autocracy and communalism.

The BCU President said the main slogan of its election campaign would be resist arms and terrorism. save Dhaka University.

The BCU President called upon the conscious students community of Dhaka University to give their verdict against arms and terrorism.

Meanwhile the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) and Chhatra League (H-A) the students fronts of BNP and Awami League are likely to announce their panel today (Friday). The possible VP, GS and AGS candidate of BCL (H-A) are Shah Alam, Syed Kamrul Ahsan and Momtazuddin Mehdi.

The nine-students organisation was continuing their meeting at the DUCSU office to select candidates till the time of writing this report at 10 p.m.
