

DUCSU polls on June 6

The Dhaka University authorities and 22 student organisations on Monday reached a consensus on the holding of DUCSU and hall union electios on June 6 and actions agaist persons, responsible for violent incidents on the campus including attack on the post-DUCSU election victory procession by female students.

Under the agreement, the Dhaka University authorities will complete all procedural formalities relating to the enquiry into the attack on victory procession by female students on February 9,1989, violent incidents in Mohsin Hall, Zahrul Huq Hall, Rokeya Hall and killing of Kanak and take actions against persons found responsible for these incidents within next six weeks.

All student organisations pledged to cooperate in the proper holding of DUCSU and hall union elections on June 6.

The meeting was attended by the Vice-Chancellor, Pro-Vice Chancellor, Provosts of Rokeya and Shamsunnahar Halls, proctor, leaders of 22 students organisations of Dhaka University Academic Environment Council and Vice-Presidents and General Secretaries of Shamsunnahar and Rokeya Halls on Monday evening.

The meeting urged all concerned to help make the June 6' elections a success.

Meanwhile, UNB says: ProAwami League Chhatra League
has finalised their candidates
for two key posts of DUCSU____

Vice President and General
Secretary — to contest the
June 6 election, party sources
said today.

They said the Chhatra League, which decided to contest the elections independently, chose Shah Alam as their nominee for DUCSU Vice President and Syed Kamrul Ahsan for the post of General Secretary. Both Alam and Kamrul are Vice Presidents of BCL (H-A).

Other candidates of the panel have not been finalised yet, he said.

Meanwhile, the CPB-backed Chhatra Union and pro-BAK-BAL Jatiya Chhatra League are reportedly busy finalising their separate panels for the DUCSU and hall union elections.

The Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD), who was the first to announce it will contest the elections independently, may finalise its panel within this week.

Insiders said the JCD is most likely to nominate Assaduzza-man Ripon as its candidate for DUCSU VP and Amanullah Aman as GS.

The left-leaning combine of nine student organisations, a group lead by pro-JSD (Inu) Chhatra League, have reportedly agreed to float a coalition panel.

The Islami Chhatra Shibir has already announced their panel for DUCSU elections with Aminul Islam Mukul nominated for the post of VP and Mulibur Rahman as GS.

The last date for submitting nomination papers for DUCSU and hall union polls is May 26.
