DUCSU call to arrest armed persons

A meeting of Dhaka University Central Students' Union (DUCSU) was held on Tuesday at the DUCSU office. The Vice-Chancellor and President of DUCSU Dr. Moniruzzaman Miah presided over the meeting.

The meeting in a resolution urged the government to arrest all accused killers, terrorists and armed persons to keep the campus free from terrorism on the eve of the opening of Dhaka University on April 7.

The meeting called for maintaining strict vigilance before opening of the halls to restrain the outsiders, armed and unwanted persons from coming to the halls.

The meeting urged the university authority to convene a joint meeting of the DUCSU and all active students organisations today (Wednesday) at 4 p.m. at the Vice-Chancellor's office.

The meeting also decided to hold a meeting representing teachers, students, officials and employees on the opening day of the University at 12 p.m.

The meeting urged the University Senate to implement the autonomy of the University in pursuance of the University Ordinance, 1973. The meeting was deferred till 10 a.m. April 9.
