DUCSU demands publication of probe report

The Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) yesterday submitted to the university authorities a memorandum demanding publication of the report by the committee which probed last year's post-DUCSU election violence by February 12.

Pro Vice Chancellor Prof Emajuddin Ahmed received the memorandum on behalf of the authorities from a DUCSU delegation led by its Vice president Sulan Moham Mansur Ahmed.

Earlier, a rally was held at the foot of Aparajeya Bangla in the morning. DUCSU VP Sultan Mohammad Mansur Ahmed and GS Mushtaq Hossain addressed the rally.

They accused the authorities of neglecting the matter and called for stern action against the persons responsible.

It may be recalled that an outsider, Kafiluddin Kanak, was shot dead and a victory procession by the female students was attacked immediately after the results of the DUCSU election were announced on February 9 last year.

Meanwhile, the combine of nine student organisations has decided to stage a sit-in in front of the vice-Chancellor's office today at 10 am in demand for trial of those responsible for the acts of violence took place on the campus over the last one year. It will also hand over a memorandum to the authorities in this connection.
