


## DUCSU leaders want polls in February

Leaders of the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) and hall unions on Tuesday rejected the proposed date of holding DUCSU polls on March 22. The student leaders urged the authorities to maintain the regularities by holding the polls in February.

The Dhaka University authorities held a meeting with the DUCSU and hall union leaders to finalise the modalities of the DUCSU election. Presided over by Vice-Chancellor Prof. Abdul Mannan the meeting reviewed the university situation for holding the students union election timely.

The student leaders opined that is DUCSU and hall union polls are not possible on March 22 as the elections of Upazilas will be held from March 12 to 24. They said many of Dhaka University students will be busy in the rural areas for upazila polls. They urged the university authorities to complete the elections by February or after the Eid-ul-Fitr.

The meeting was concluded without taking any decision. The authorities will meet soon, it is learnt.
