

The DUCSU also urged the concerned authorities to strictly impose the Proctorial rules with a view to prevent entry of the armed outsiders and unwanted persons into the student dormitories.

The DUCSU convened a joint meeting of the leaders of all the student organisations active on the Dhaka University campus at the Vice Chancellor's office at 4 p.m. today (Wednesday) to find out joint measures in this regard.

The DUCSU proposed the holding of a general meeting of the teachers-students-officials and employees at 12 noon on April 7 to discuss sieps to free the campus from armed terrorism.

The DUCSU in a resolution demanded that the senate be active immediately to protect, the University Order 73.

The meeting was held at the DUCSU office on Tuesday and adjourned till 10 am. on April 9.

Besides the DUCSU President Prof. M. Maniruzzaman Miah, the meeting Was attended among others by the DUCSU Vice-President Sultan Muhammad Monsur Ahmed, General Secretary Mushtaq Hossain and Assistant General Secretary Nasirud-Doza.
