

## Electioneering in DU continues

Electioneering for the ensuing polls to the Dhaka University Central Students Union (DUCSU) and Halls Student Unions continued for the second consecutive day on Monday.

Different student organisations held projection meetings, rallies and brought out processions in support of their candidates. Processions went round the Arts Faculty Building and the Curzon Hall from morning till mid day. Election fever was marked at the TSC and women students' halls area in the afternoon and inside the residential halls till mid-night.

The Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) is yet to patch up the differences regarding finalising an unanimous panel for the

DUCSU Close door meeting was continuing at the BNP office till writing this report on Monday night with a view to decide an agreed panel. But the BNP Chairperson Begum Zia was said to be adamant about her earlier decision for Aman-Khokon and Alam panel it is learnt.

Besides in DUCSU the JCD candidates filed more than one panel in some student dormitories.

The Secretary General of the Jamaat-e-Islami Bangladesh Maulana Matiur Rahman Nizami in a statement on Monday condemned the attack on five leaders and workers of Bangladesh Islami Chhatra Shibir including the VP candidate to the DUCSU Aminul Islam Mukul.

The Jamaat-e-Islami Bangladesh Dhaka City Unit Ameer Abdul Kader Mollah and Secretary A T M Azharul Islam in another joint statement also condemned the attack.

A Shibir press release said that supporters of Islami Chhatra Shibir brought out protest processions and held rallies in different parts of the country condemning the attack on Shibir leaders and workers.

Freedom Party Chairperson Colonel (Retd) Syed Farook Rahman on Monday stressed the need of open discussion among the student organisations irrespective of political identity to find out different problems in the field of higher education and find out the means and ways to solve those problems.

Colonel Farook was exchanging views with the candidates to the DUCSU set by the Sh

khathi Forum led by Shariful Islam and Mokhlesur Rahman.

The procession brought out by Bangladesh Chhatra League (H-A) ended in front of the DUCSU building. DUCSU VP Sultan Mohammad Monsur Ahmed led the procession which was followed by a brief rally. BCL President Habibur Rahman Habib addressed the rally. The Combine of the Nine Student Organisations and JCD also brought out separate processions on the campus.

But the JCD did not chant any slogan in support of any of its three panels for the DUCSU.
