JCD, BCL workers clash: Rajendra College closed

FARIDPUR, Feb. 27:—Rajendra University College here was closed for four days after Chhatral League and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal activists clashed this morning, leaving seven students injured, reports UNB.

The college authorities also ordered the students to vacate the hostel by this evening as tension mounted in and around the campus.

College sources said the clash erupted when a procession of Bangladesh Chhatra League (H-A) workers protesting the killing of Dhaka University student leader Shahidul Islam Chunnu came under attack by rival students.

The trouble started when the procession brought out from the college campus was passing by of the nearby Polytechnic Institute where the Jativatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) activists were holding the installation ceremony of the institute's student.

union, sources said.

The JCD and Chhatra League (H-A) activists exchanged brickbats and chased each other.

Injured students, one of them seriously, were taken to the General Hospital. Six of them were released after first aid.

Chhatra League held a protest rally in the afternoon in front of the Alipur Janata Bank. Presided over by liakat, the rally was addressed, among others, by Faroot and

Wasim.

Police were posted at important points of the fown to avert further untoward incidents.
