Police raid DU hall

Nearly 20 students and police were injured as police raided the Jagannath hall of the Dhaka University yesterday night to flush out the reported armed outsiders from the hall, report agencies.

The injured students included the president and general secretary of the Jagannath hall unit of Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-A).

Earlier, police fired tear gas shells and charged batons when the students tried to resist them with brick bats. At one stage police entered the rooms of the students and beat many of them.

Another source said police stormed the hall yesterday night to arrest Oyee, Sajal and Liaquat for their alleged involvement in the killing of Dr Milon. Police acted on a tip that they were staying in the hall.

Police version on the incident was not available.

Around midnight last night, the Chhatra League (A-A) activists set ablaze a motor-cycle and ransacked the Provost's office at

Jagannath Hall, apparently protesting the police raid.

All points of entry of the university campus were closed to traffic.
