Reopening of DU in Ramzan demanded

The Nine-party Students Alliance on Wednesday demanded reopening of Dhaka University and urged the authorities to take classes and examinations in the month of Ramzan for eliminating session jam.

The Students Alliance was addressing a Press conference at the DUCSU office. DUCSU General Secretary Mushtaq Hossain, Alliance leader Nazmul Haque Pradhan and Abdus Sattar Khan spoke on the occasion.

The nine student organisations held the Government responsible for armed terrorism in the University. It said that the Government was interfering with the day-to-day affairs of the University without directing the sources of illegal arms in the University.

The Nine-party Students Alliance called upon the respective student organisations to expel their armed members for creating a better atmosphere for student politics.

The students alliance demanded trial of the culprits responsible for terrorism in the University. It urged the varsity authorities to publish the reports of the inquiry commissions constituted for different incidents in the University.

The nine student organisations stressed the need for holding the session of the Senate immediately for restoration of "congenial academic atmosphere on the campus."

The nine student organisations hoped that the new Vice Chancellor will work neutrally to safeguard the 1973 Ordinance of the University.
