

Shibir gheraos CU Proctor's office

CHITTAGONG, Nov 3 (UNB): Islami Chhatra Shibir activists yesterday (Sunday) laid a two-hour siege on Chittagong University Proctor's office demanding punishment of the "terrorists" who attacked them on the campus on August 14.

The Shibirites also reiterated their demand for removal of Vice Chancellor Prof Alamgir Mohammad Sirajuddin and adequate arrangements for holding forthcoming examinations peacefully.

On the other side, Chhatra League (A-A) held a rally at Railway Station near the campus in observance of Jail Killing Day to commemorate the death of four Awami League leaders in Dhaka Central Jail on November 3, 1975.

The BCL leaders in the rally urged the government to scrap the Indemnity Ordinance for eradicating terrorism and for the sake of democracy.

Presided over by CUCSU VP Mohammad Nazim Uddin, the rally was addressed by Anup Khastagir, Mokaddas Ali and Shafiul Alam Bashir.
