

Student bodies put up 18 panels

CHITTAGONG. Although the All Party Students Alliance could ultimately come out with an agreed panel its component student hodies appear to have turned down that consensus panel by pushing through respective separate panels for both "CUCSU" and six hall union elections. According to University nomination papers submitted by the contenders showed 18 separate panels. There were altogether 110 nomination papers submitted for just 10 executive member posts of "CUCSU".

Chhatra Front central President Mustafa Faruque spoke among others on the occasion.

Mr. Nazimuddin of Jatiyo Chhatra League and Mr Azimuddin of Samajtantrik Chhatra Front were named vice-President and general secretary nominees of the CUAPSU in CUCSU polls.
