Students clash at Ctg: Two killed

CHITTAGONG, Jan 1 : At least two students were killed and 20 others injured in an armed clash between two rival groups of student at Jafatnagar of Fatikchhari upazila this afternoon.

The victims were said to be members of Ganotantrik Chhatra Shakti, a student front of National Democratic Party.

Police said the students died on the spot were Jasimuddin (22) and Mohammad Shahjahan (24). Of the injured persons, three were admitted to Chittagong Medical College Hospital (CMCH) with serious bullet injuries while four others were admitted to Fatikchhari Upazila Health Complex. The rest were given first aid at the health complex.

The clash ensued between the workers of Ganotantrik Chhatra Shakti and the Awami League backed Chhatra League (H-A).

While contacted, Fatikchhari police station, 32 km off the spot of occurrence, could not give details of the incident. But eye witnesses said the clash originated from a local restaurant where a group of

students was resting.

POLYTECHNIC

One Mizanur Rahman, a student of Chittagong Polytechnic Institute, received bullet injuries in a clash between two groups of students ensued from rivalry. The clash began in front of the institute yesterday.

Meanwhile, BCL (H-A) unit of Polytechnic Institute in a statement alleged that a few members of JCD hijacked tender notice box from the college office at gun point.

Hence, contractors could not submit their tenders for a development work of the institute, the statement added.

25 HURT IN CLASHES

Another report said, more than 25 persons were injured in two separate clashes at Pantiya yesterday. Seven of the injured were in critical condition.

The first clash occurred at the village of Dakkinbursi between two rival groups in which two persons were injured.

In another clash over construction of a public latrine 23 persons were injured. Five of the injured were admitted to a
