

Suspend JCD activities on DU campus: Nasim

Opposition Chief Whip Mohammad Nasim Sunday said that peace and healthy academic environment in Dhaka University will remain a far cry without the government taking action against "terrorists of BNP student wing," reports UNB.

He said the Prime Minister will have to suspend activities of the Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal in the Dhaka University, purge JCD of the students expelled by the university and take legal action against the identified terrorists of JCD.

"Otherwise, there is little chance of restoration of peace in the Dhaka University campus", a Nasim added.

Talking to UNB, the Awami League Publicity Secretary said Party Chief Sheikh Hasina took the lead for restoring academic environment at Dhaka University by suspending the activities of her own student wing -- Chhatra League.

"But unfortunately the Prime Minister had failed to rise above party politics and ban (JCD) activities on the campus", Nasim said. On the contrary, he alleged, armed terrorism of the JCD had spread even to the Secretariat.

Nasim recalled the Awami League government's action against Shafiul Alam Pradhan who was General Sccretary of Bangladesh Chhatra League in 1974. Pradhan was arrested for his alleged involvement in the seven murder case at Mohsin Hall of Dhaka University.

He expressed his utter surprise at the government's failure in arresting the identified terrorists, who were also expelled from the Dhaka University.
