

### Govt college teachers give ultimatum

Bangladesh Government College Lecturers' Association (BGCLA) at an emergency meeting yesterday (Monday) threatened to launch a greater movement if their 12-point demand was not met by November 10, reports UNB.

The lecturers have been observing work abstention since September 30 to press their demands.

Their demands include filling up of 6,000 vacant posts of lecturers, promotion of lecturers, creation of 3,000 posts in the 114 assimilated government colleges and regularisation of services in the government colleges.

The meeting held at Dhaka College Teachers' auditorium yesterday afternoon was chaired by BGCLA President Kamal Aatur Rahman. It was addressed by Nazreen Begum of Jagannath University College, Abdus Samad of Dhaka College, Omar Farooq of Bangla College and Sultana Begum of Badrunnesa College.
