

Teachers of CM College begin class boycott

RANGPUR, June 23: Teachers of Rangpur Charnichael University College started boycotting classes for an indefinite period from Thursday.

The boycott began in protest against the ransacking of the residences of five teachers reportedly by a group of students Wednesday night. They also went on a rampage on the campus.

Sources alleged that the students became violent as they were not allowed to use college bus for carrying the body of a student of the college from Rangpur Medical College Hospital (RMCH) to his village home in Mithapukur.

Harun Al Rashid, a BA student of the college, died of heart failure at the RMCH Wednesday evening.

Three students were arrested in this connection.
