He said that a special programme had been developed in sooperation with the Minis try of Home Affairs which 20,000 members of the Village Defence Party (VDP) would be engaged in imparting one lakh VDP members. One lakh primers will be given to them he added.

Hesides a good number of voluntary organisations includ. ing jute mills were also show ing interest in the programme They are being supplied with primers and necessary reading materials, he added.

The Prime Minister who is also in charge of the Ministry of Education said that the programme had been worked out with the four Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education for students' partici pation in mass literacy as part of school curriculum. Fifty marks will be allotted in the SSC examination of 1980.81 and onward for this work, hesaid.

Programmes on mass educa. tion were being organised more or less on regular basis on radio and television. Infor mation was also being released to national newspapers from time to time, Shah Aziz said/
