"Jihad-e-Sazandegi" is to guarantee the ideal atmosphere pointed out in the previous holy verse.

Accordingly, various committees were formed in "Jihad-e-Sazandegi", such as agricultural, medical, constructional, veterinary, to offer their services to the countryside, to improve life conditions, and struggle for the welfare of the countryside instead of the misery under the defunct regime. Through these central committees, branches and off-shoots were created in all the provinces, cities and villages, nationwide, which did and still do their best to help the rural areas.

However, when the enemy invaded our country by directing its troops to conquer our territories, villages, and border cities, executing an arrogant plan to destroy the Revolution, "Jihad-e-Sazandegi", did not sit back and watch these events with folded arms, but, in addition to its duties, it formed the "war-support headquarters", to perform its legal duty of defending the Revolution, and its achievements, and of deterring the enemy, for which Imam Khomeini said, "Without Jihad-e-Sazandegi, we would not have attained victory in such a short period."

From these headquarters, many branches have been established, to carry out its tasks in the war fronts.

WAR-SUPPORT HEADQUARTERS' DUTIES

A- War Engineering: It represents the headquarter's pivotal activities, such as establishing wooden or iron bridges, cutting roads into the mountain sides, and the front sectors of the battlefields includes making dirt roads in the marshes, erecting embankments in the front lines of the battlefields, and digging long ditches and building singular and group bunkers. Beyond this scope, the activities of the headquarters go on... airstrips for choppers at the fronts are being made, sites for rocket-launchers and radars in mountainous and difficult terrain

against the aggressors, in spite of all the obstacles, the war drags on, but the people, themselves, manage the war, and they support financially as well as with manpower, so they are the decision-makers.

Wherever the War-Support Headquarters declares its need for bulldozer-drivers, surveyors, construction workers, technicians for building bridges, or engineers, the volunteers come in greater numbers to the headquarters, and its branches, to enlist themselves, in order to be transferred to the front.

C-Collecting people's gifts and sending them to the fronts : This activity is being carried out through many channels, the most important of them being the mosques. The mosques collect the financial and material gifts and contributions, and the headquarters, deposits the financial aid in the front's accounts and forward the material gifts to the fronts. People also, present their gifts to the representatives of the headquarters in the Friday congregational prayers, which are performed all over the country. These gifts are foodstuff, like rice, flour, ghee, fruits, canned foods, money, gold jewelry, cars, trucks, bulldozers, water containers, clothes, blankets, household utensils, stoves, drugs etc.

D-Educational information at the fronts : In this respect the headquarters mobilizes students from the theological schools, to deliver sermons, at the fronts, and to arrange ideological classes in the trenches and bunkers. Useful and entertaining, educational films are being shown on videos. It offers radio sets, recorders, Qurans, prayer books, and Islamic political, jurisprudence books to the combatants. The information units arrange fests, and congregations on different occasions such as the birth anniversary of the Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W.) and the martyrdom of Imam Hussein across the front.

E-Offering medical services in the battlefields : The "Jihad-e-Sazandegi" did its best in sending

other Salavati services.

Some of the activities carried out by the war-support headquarters, during the operations of Thaminul A'imma, Tariq Al-Quds, Fath Al-Mubin, Baitul-Moqadis, Ramadhan, Muslim Bin Aqeel, Muharram and Walfajr.
