JN Varsity student shot dead, another body found in DU

A student of Jagannath University was gunned down in the city early Monday, police and hospital sources said, reports UNB.

He was identified as Zahidur Rahman Jewel, 22, son of one Bazlur Rahman at 167, Rajuk Extension Road.

Police said three youths in a microbus brought him to a Siddeswari clinic at 69. Circular Road at about 5 am. -

But the attending doctors of Utsarga Nursing Home declared him dead. The three youths fled the scene with the microbus when Jewel was declared dead.

The physicians informed Ramna police and they sent the body to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) morgue.

Quoting hospital sources, UNB DMCH correspondent reported that the dead had bullet wounds on his forehead.

Family sources said Jewel lest the house on Sunday evening and did not return. An uncle of him received an anonymous phone on Monday evening that Jewel was admitted to Utsarga Clinic.

Receiving the news, he rushed to the clinic but he was informed about the death of an unidentified youth. Later, Jewel's uncle identified him at the DMCH morgue.

 Ramna police registered a case in connection with the unnatural death.

BODY FOUND

 An unidentified youngman was slaughtered in the Dhaka University, now closed for Durga Puja, in the small hours Monday, police said.

They, however, confirmed that the youth, aged about 25, was not a student of the university. He was wearing white shirt and blue trousers.

Some small boys and girls, while picking up dried leaves, found the body near a building of the Ceramic department of the Fine Arts Institute at about 10 in the morning.

Ramna police later recovered the body from the desolate. spot behind the university's International Hostel which

house the foreign students. The victim's hands, legs and mouth were tied with black cloths. Besides deep injuries on his throat, there were five stab wounds on the body.

The body was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital morgue for autopsy.
