

GCO demonstration Tomorrow

Ganotantrik Chhatra Oikk-ya (GCO) at a meeting yesterday shifted the procession and demonstration programme scheduled for today to tomorrow.

GCO, a conglomeration of some Left leaning student organisations, was scheduled to hold a rally today on the DU campus today to press for re-opening of Jahangirnagar University (JU) and withdrawal of its increased admission fees.

GCO leaders said that the change in schedule was due to the opposition called hartal today. The meeting also decided to hold a students' convention on the Dhaka University campus on November 20 to press home its several demands. The demands include withdrawal of what they termed as 'anti-education' and 'anti-student' statement of 11 Vice Chancellors, resumption of student bus service at Chittagong University and disclosure of the identity of some 60 enlisted terrorists of DU.

The GCO leaders also expressed grave concern over the closure of JU and its authorities' threat to agitating JU students.

Presided over by Dipanker Saha Dipu, the rally was addressed, among others, by Nurul Islam, Hasan Tariq Chowdhury Sohel, Saifur Rahman Tapon, Imam Gajjali, Sabbah Ali Khan Koline and Rahman Mizan.

Meanwhile, agitating JU students under the banner of Increased Fee Resistance Committee (IFRC) also shifted its earlier announced students' and guardians' solidarity rally to tomorrow due to the hartal, a press release said.
