to present correct and factual books to the future citizens of the country. But due to some limitations its efforts were hampered, he added. Mr. Nuruddin-al-Masud, Additional Secretary, Ministry of Education, was present on the occasion.

The Chairman of the board said that the board had to print 85 books. But it had no printing press of its own. A total number of about five and a half crore books were printed in 212 private owned presses. Even one set of book was printed in different printing presses. As a result printing mistakes had taken place as all the presses were not of the same standard, he said. Mr. Eliasuddin said that the text books were written and examined by experts available in the country.
