Books worth Tk/10 crore imported

Bangladesh imported books worth about Taka 10 crore as against export of books of about Taka 20 lakh during 1987-88. There is prospect of increasing the export market of Bangladeshi books.

Mr. Mohiuddin Ahmed of Exporter Committee of Bangladesh Publishers said this at a news conference at a local hotel on Wednesday. Mr. Ahmed also introduced an Indian delegation of publishers now in the city in connection with promotion of book trade between the two countries. Led by Mr. Machawe, the delegation met Education Secretary, high officials of the Commerce Ministry, university teachers and writers with the proposals of co-publication of books.
