Body to remove errors in text books dissolved

Openment has dissolved the committee formed earlier for removing linguistic errors and informative flaws from the text-books following creation of con-

troversy on the issue.

A Press Note issued by the Education Ministry said today that the attention of the government was drawn to some news items published in a section of the Press on correction of text books at primary and secondary levels. The government views that there is possibility of misunderstanding among the members of the public as these news items have not reflected the real objectives of the government the Press note said.

In fact the Press note said the government was neither contemplating fundamental change of text books and curriculum nor had directed for writing "creator" instead of "Allah" in the text books.

The government did not issued any directive to stop the printing of text books the Press note said adding the work for printing of text books was stopped for two days because of some misunderstanding.

The printing of text books has resumed and the government feels that there is no possibility of delay in publishing and supply of text books for the 1991 academic year.
