Higher level text book in Bangla Integrated plan to meet requirement taken

Bangla Academy and University Grants Commission (UGC) have jointly taken an integrated programme to meet the requirement of text books in Bangla for higher level education in the country.

Under this integrated Programme, Bangla Academy will spend Taka on crore for formulation and publication of text books in Bangla for the university level education by the financial year 1991-92.

This was disclosed by the Director General of Bangla Academy Prof M Harunar Rashid at a news conference at the academy confer-

ence room in the afternoon.

As a part of the programme, Bangla Academy and the UGC are jointly organising five workshops on "formulation of text book in Bangla for higher level education" at the Academy seminar room beginning today (Saturday).

The area of the first day's workshop is Physical science while workshop on other areas will be held as follows: Biological science on May 5, Social sciences on May 15, Arts on May 16 and Law and Commerce on May 18.

Delegates from all universities of the country representing their respective subject will join the

workshop to evaluate previous programmes in this regard and assess the requirement met so far, listing of books published and identifications of quality of those books, identification of areas neglected so far, listing the interested and skilled writers of text books from different universities and from other institutions, listing of text books needed to formulate in accordance with the university syllabus, identification of problems in formulation of text books and finalisation of recommendations to solve the problems.

Bangla Academy DG, Prof M Harun-ar-Rashid said that about 20 per cent requirement of text book in Bangla for higher level education had met so far and a massive programme was needed to fulfil the rest.
