Ershad unhappy over Education Directorate affairs

President Ershad yesterday morning paid a surprise visit to Education Directorate at the western end of Abdul Ghani Road, reports BSS.

During the visit, he expressed his utter dissatisfaction at the state of affairs at the Directorate.

The President found files and office materials laying scattered for years in a dirty condition and not properly maintained. He observed no office can run in this condition.

He wondered if Education Directorate is in such a shamble state, then how the nation can expect results of increasing expenditures for development of education.

President Ershad regretted that the atmosphere in Education Directorate is not at all favourable for any work.

He directed the concerned authority to bring office discipline and organise the directorate in an orderly manner. He instructed to put restrictions on entry of outsiders in the office. He told them that he will visit the office a month after when he expects the office will look like headquarters of directorate.

The President also talked to some of the visitors at the office and wanted to know from them their purpose of visit.
