Why not at Mahasthangarh?

The Islamic Centre will be set up in Bangladesh in tour years time at an estimated cost of 20 'million US dollars of which 17.429 million dollars will be financed by the Islamic Secretariat. The centre, which will be residential, aims at developing the vast human resources of the Islamic countries by imparting technical and vocational education in 10 technologies and 20 trades with an annual intake capacity of 1100 trainees.
